

NAME IT – SPELL IT:

NAME IT – SPELL IT – Screens with real speech to practice naming objects. Click on the correct word or drag and drop to complete the sentence and advance to the next screen. Older / more able pupils may wish to spell the word. Over 130 screens in 14 categories including animals, toys and the main parts of the body (see below for more details). Ages 4 – 6 / older second language / special needs.

The activities are self-correcting and may be used for individual or group activities with minimum teacher supervision. Children should be encouraged to click the mouse on the various buttons and on text and images with speech support.

NAME IT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Left click on an image on the menu page to enter the first page of the chosen category.
2. Right click on an image on the menu page to enter the alphabetic directory for the chosen category.
3. Move the mouse over the text to hear it spoken
4. Click on the sound icon to turn the music off.
5. Click on the house icon to return to the menu page.
6. Click 'P' on the keyboard to print a screen.
7. Click on the correct word or drag and drop the correct word into the empty box to advance to the next screen.
8. Click on the open door icon to exit the program.

SPELL IT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Left click on an image to enter the first page of the chosen category.
2. Right click on an image to enter the directory for the chosen category.
3. Move the mouse over the text to hear it spoken.
4. Click on the sound icon to turn the music off.
5. Click on the house icon to return to the menu page.
6. Click 'P' on the keyboard to print a screen.
7. Use the keyboard to type the missing word, then press enter to advance to the next screen.
8. Click on the open door icon to exit the program.

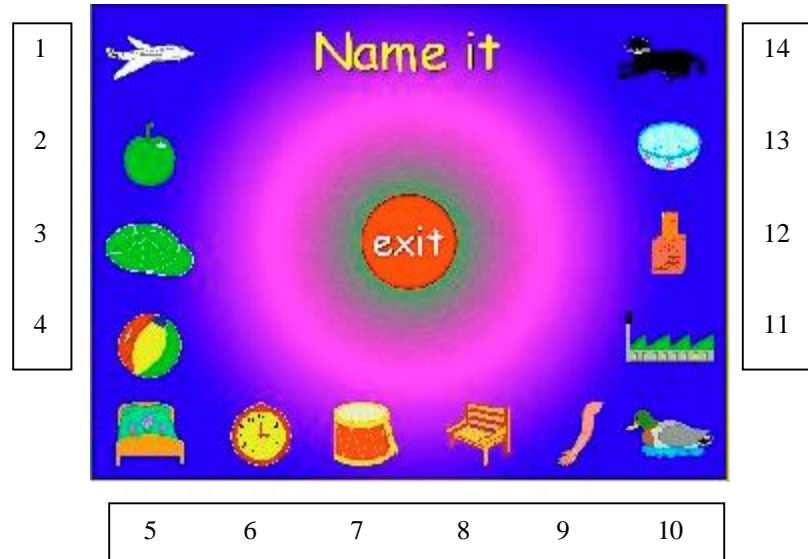
THE SCREENS:

The 14 categories on the opening screen are: transport, foods, clothes, toys, furniture, electrical, musical garden, the body, birds (animals), buildings, house parts, crockery and cutlery, animals.

The categories may be opened in any order. Left click to open the first screen in the chosen category. Right click to open the directory for the chosen category where the images are arranged in alphabetic order.

THE CATEGORIES:



1. TRANSPORT: There are 15 items to name or spell in this category - aeroplane, ambulance, bike, boat, bus, car, helicopter, lorry, motor bike, scooter, ship, tractor, train, van and yacht.

2. FOODS: There are 15 items to name or spell in this category - apple, bread, cake, chips, egg, ice cream, jelly, milk, orange, pizza, pop, sausages.

3. CLOTHES: There are 12 items to name or spell in this category - cap, dress, glove, hat, jacket, jumper, scarf, shirt, shoe, skirt, sock, trousers.

4. TOYS: There are 15 items to name or spell in this category - ball, bat, blocks, doll, frisbee, jigsaw, kite, racket, robot, see-saw, slide, swing, teddy, trolley, yo-yo.

5. FURNITURE: There are 12 items to name or spell in this category - bed, cabinet, chair, cot, desk, drawers, dresser, sofa, stool, table, toy box, wardrobe.

6. ELECTRICAL: There are 12 items to name or spell in this category - clock, computer, cooker, fridge, kettle, lamp, microwave, radio, torch, telephone, television, video.

7. MUSICAL: There are 5 items to name or spell in this category – drum, guitar, trumpet, violin, xylophone.
8. GARDEN: There are 6 items to name or spell in this category - bench, gazebo, greenhouse, lawn mower, shed, spade.
9. THE BODY: There are 8 items to name or spell in this category - arm, ear, eye, hand, head, leg, mouth, nose.
10. BIRDS: There are 6 items to name or spell in this category - duck, hen, ostrich, owl, robin, swan.
11. BUILDINGS: There are 5 items to name or spell in this category - factory, flats, house, lighthouse, tower.
12. HOUSE PARTS: There are 5 items to name or spell in this category - chimney, door, roof, wall, window.
13. CROCKERY AND CUTLERY: There are 8 items to name or spell in this category - bowl, cup, fork, jug, knife, plate, spoon, teapot.
14. ANIMALS: There are 19 items to name or spell in this category - cat, cow, deer, dog, elephant, fish, fox, frog, giraffe, horse, kangaroo, lion, mole, mouse, pig, rabbit, sheep, snake, zebra.

THE PACK AND THE CURRICULUM:

The pack is designed to encourage young children to speak, listen, understand and respond to others and to take part in group discussions within the familiar context of everyday objects. It is also designed to help children recognise and spell familiar words.

THE GRAPHICS:

The graphics used are simple purpose made vector drawings for three reasons:

- a) they are child friendly and easy to recognize.
- b) they support the program without being a distraction in themselves.
- c) they require less memory than more sophisticated graphics / illustrations.

INCLUSION:

Generally speaking, the screens are uncluttered with little visible text. This reduces the amount of initial explanation / signing required on introducing the screens to pupils with hearing problems.

The high graphic content of the screens helps to overcome language barriers, making the pack suitable for mainstream, special needs or second language pupils.

Non-readers may click on the text or graphics to hear the words spoken.

The self correcting aspect of the program is very gentle with nothing to draw attention to children who find it difficult to grasp the concepts involved. They may proceed by trial and error at their own pace.

The activities have a 'drag and drop' option and are suitable for touch screens.

TEACHER CONTROL:

The words are of random difficulty. However, the teacher may use the alphabet directory within each category to choose suitable words for the intended users.

INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARDS:

The screens in this pack have been redesigned for more efficient use with Interactive Whiteboards and are ideal for individual or group work and whole class teaching.

INSTALLATION:

The pack self installs. Insert the CD in the CD drive and follow the instructions on the screen.
